Faithful Friar Message

Directly put – the major thrust of October is "Respect Life". On Sunday, Oct 7, we celebrate "Respect Life Sunday". Much will be written, but will be shared from various church pulpits that weekend about the Dignity of Life and Respect for all Life.

Anything that may be written is best summarized with the following intercession: "we pray for <u>all life</u> from the <u>moment</u> to <u>conception to</u> <u>natural death</u>! At times many people get confused, panic-stricken, shocked or ignorant toward stem cell research! "Concern for Human Life".

As sincere Roman Catholics we must be alert to all jargon and not get confused with many terms or phrases. Being very direct and specific – as members of the Roman Catholic Church we **oppose** only one form of stem cell research – ie: <u>Embroyonic Stem Cell Research</u>. The Roman Catholic Church sustains <u>no moral problem</u> with umbilical cord stem cells, adult stem cells or embroyonic germ cell research. I have written those few words to clarify the Church position on all life – summed up directly in our understanding of stem cell research.

Brothers, let us always be alert to the joy of the above mentioned intercessions – "we pray for all life from the moment of conception to natural death".
